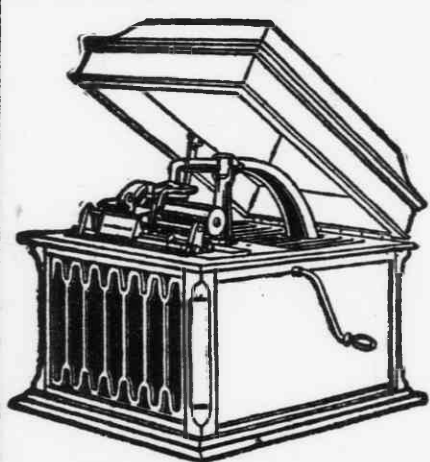

Will History Repeat Itself In 5th District

The Democracy of the Fifth District had as well now as later face the probable fact that Holton is so the Republican nominee for Congress this year. This is neither a laughing nor a sneering matter. The fact is so strongly Democratic that it is impossible to slip something over one's head in a while. In fact, there are mighty few voters too young to remember when John Motley Morehead, Republican, was our representative. It is needless to go into the wherewith of that stinging defeat, sufficient to say that the Democrats were divided on a nominee and the Republicans got up a strong, virile business man, Holton is a man in the habit of doing and getting things. He has just done some sixteen years of faithful and efficient service as prosecutor for the Government. If there is anything against the record of the man, we never heard it. In debate, he is a power, and against a weak man he licks would have telling force. The whole truth, in our belief, no man could beat him in the Fifth.

We do not think that Major Stedman's best friends regard him as a strong man in any sense. He is a Confederate Soldier, that said, the strength of his hand is about told. His friends obtained the first nomination for him on that score. He was a soldier of Lee and growing old, he wanted the honor one time. It was given to him. Again the people of the Fifth honored him. Two terms in Congress, and Major Stedman has either accomplished or tried to accomplish anything of any consequence, we have yet to hear of it. Certainly he has not kept his promises to his brothers in arms. There were scores of healthy appointments in his charge that might have gone to old veterans. Did they get them? No, sir. The Major was "playing politics," and very unskillfully at that. We believe, according to the evidence, he has only put two in office, one at Madison, another at Lenoir, and both in Rockingham county. The extent of his love for and promises to the old Confederate soldier! Where and when has he raised his voice in their behalf? What one important thing has he done or tried to do for the great Imperial Fifth? He has swung on the Wilson guy rope, and let the show roll on.

Major Stedman has had the honor long enough. The people feel that they are now entitled to a real representative in Congress. If the Democracy of Guilford county still "joined to her idols," we may expect history to repeat itself. Democracy of the Fifth is not united on Stedman. We must be solid on some good, strong man. Vance Guano Company To Enlarge Its Plant.

PLANS ARE NOT YET COMPLETE, BUT BOTH CAPACITY AND OUTPUT OF PRESENT PLANT MAY BE MORE THAN DOUBLED AT AN EARLY DATE.

It is understood that the Vance Guano Company, one of the best known and most successful manufacturing enterprises of this city and section, is planning to greatly increase both the capacity and output of its already large plant just west of town.

While the plans for the enlargement are not yet complete, it is known that they are to be on an extensive scale and are to mean much not only to the Vance Guano Company but to the city as well. It is possible that both the capacity and output of the present plant will be more than doubled.

The products of the Vance Guano Company have from year to year been constantly increasing in popular favor with the farmers throughout this section of the State until this enlargement of their plant on a big scale has become necessary in order to meet the demands for their fertilizers. —Henderson Gold Leaf.

Sunday School Institute

Arrangements are being made to hold a Sunday-School Institute at Trinity College, Durham, N. C., June 11, 12, and 13, 1914. This institute is a continuation of a similar work begun in the summer of 1911 and which proved so successful at that time. The purpose of the institute is to furnish to Sunday School-workers of whatever denomination opportunity to study this phase of church work. Some of the most widely known Sunday School experts of this region have been secured for the work, and final arrangements will soon be made for it. In accordance with the action of the North Carolina Conference of the Methodist Episcopal Church in 1910, a very profitable institute for training Sunday School workers was held at Trinity College in the summer of 1911 under the auspices of the Sunday School Board of that Conference. Plans were begun for a continuation of this work in the summer of 1912 and 1913, but unavoidable conditions and circumstances prevented the holding of the institute.
