A TERRIBLE ACCIDENTT．
Yơn；Man Kifled in a Potaty Tunnel Tuesday．
The Lenoir Topic of Wednesday gives the follow－ ing account of a terrible acci－ dent：

Joseph Perkins，the 17 － rear－old son of Mr．Thos． Perkins，of John｀River，was killed in a potato tunnel ves－ terday evening．He and an older brother were at work in the tunnel cleaning out dirt which had caved in．The one who was killed had gone to the house near by，a short while before the sad occurrence， and while away the tunnel began to cave in and caught the one still at work．covering the lower part of his body， and fastening him．He called for help and just as they com－ menced the work of rescue． another portion of the tunnel， nearer the front，caved in． comoletely sovering him up and injuri $g$ him internalls． Another little brother about ten rears old andasister were at the mouth of the tunnel at the time．The little girl was aught but aot injured．The little boy was the only one who could go for assistance． The father was about three－ fourth，of a mile awas and the mother wion away visiting a sick sister．
－It was but a short while． however ，ill they were res－ cuel，but the one entirely covered up was dead．The other sustained no serious
