## Death of Valued Citizen of Pilot Mountain

John M. Redman died at Martin Memorial hospital at 8:45 Monday morning June 11th being 70 years old at the time of his death. He had been in ill health for some months, but grew suddenly worse four weeks previous to his death and was carried to the hospital where every thing possible was done for him but to no avail. Two of his daughters Misses Virginia and Annie were constantly with him, the other member of the family coming often to see him. He was married to Mary Ruth Roberts who with four daughters Misses Carrie, Virginia, Annie and Mrs. Arthur Fulk survive him. He also leaves two brothers J. W. Redman of Pilot Mountain and W. S. Redman of Ararat, and scores of nieces and nephews representing three generations, a large number of whom attended the funeral and paid the last tribute of respect and love to "Uncle John".

He had for many years been a member of the Baptist church and took great interest in all the work of the church. As long as his health permitted he would go often to see how the work on the new Baptist church now being erected was progressing. The funeral was held in the Methodist church conducted by his pastor Rev. Mr. Lennay assisted by Rev. C. C. Haymore and Rev. Eugene Olive, of Mount Airy. Fitting tributes were paid to the faithful christian life he had lived. Pilot Mountain had been his home for many years and he was ever ready to hold out a hand of welcome to the stranger who came that way. ## Two Are Killed as Trains Collide

Greensboro, June 8.—Road Inspector John H. Medaris and Engineer Samuel Langdon were instantly killed at 2 o'clock yesterday afternoon when freight train No. 160 collided with yard engine No. 517 on the A. & Y. railroad, about two miles northwest of Greensboro, near the paying plant of the Murray Construction Company. George C. Critz, engineer on the freight train, saved his life by jumping when the wreck occurred. He sustained painful but not serious bruises. The two firemen also escaped with minor injuries, the same being true of Captain Bilbro, who was in charge of the shifter.

The cause of the collision has not been determined. The freight train was coming toward Greensboro and the yard engine was proceeding from the city backing out. The freight engine struck the tender of the yard locomotive. Mr. Medaris was riding on the fireman's seat when the collision occurred. He was pinned under the freight engine, rendering extraction impossible until the engine could be raised.

Engineer Langdon was on the shifter when the fatal crash came. The shifter stayed on the track in spite of the great impact of the collision, but the freight engine left the track, turning to the left and landing about 20 feet away, after plunging over a 10-foot embankment.
