Bacon, Ned Johnson and others and beginning at a horn beam on the west side of Johnson Creek and runs north 83 deg. west with Sparger's line 23.75 chs. to a poplar, Davis G. Smith's corner; thence south 15 deg. east 300 feet; thence with the branch as it meanders south 200 feet; south 14 deg. east 200 feet; thence south 14 1-2 deg. west 200 feet; thence south 9 1-2 deg. east 300 feet; thence south 25 deg. east 300 feet to a stake, Barker and Smith corner on the north side of branch; thence crossing branch south 52 deg.
