 Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Mount Airy:

1. That in addition to special privilege or license tax heretofore levied there shall be levied and collected for the fiscal year 1926-1927 from July 1, 1926 to June 30, 1927 a special privilege or license tax on persons, firms and corporations engaged in hauling and delivering to merchants and to others engaged in the retail business as follows:
 On each truck of one ton or less capacity, \$30.00
 On each truck of more than one ton and less than three tons capacity \$30.00
 On each truck of over three tons capacity \$40.00
 Provided however, that such privilege or license tax shall be collectable only from each and every person or corporation or firm selling at wholesale and delivering by trucks any bread, cakes and other baker's products and such firms, persons and corporations as are selling and delivering ice cream by trucks by wholesale.

2. That the license or privilege taxes herein provided for and assessed shall not be construed as a tax upon wholesale merchants delivering other goods to retail merchants nor shall it be construed as levying a special tax or assessment on persons selling products to consumers or to produce dealers from products of their own farms.

3. That the aforesaid ordinances shall be in force from and after ratification.
