Adda 66 More Miles To Sta

Rainigh, Oct. 19.—The state highway commissioners today added a total of 86 miles to the highway system and awarded contracts to low bidders on 11 projects on which bids

Additional projects included a road from Graham to Pittsboro and from Graham to Chapel Hill. The first road will open up the southern part of Orange and Alamance counties affording them an outlet to the south without following route number 10 as it swings northward through Hillaboro and Durham.

Two delegations appeared before the commissioners from Craven county asking that the roads already or the system in that county be improve ed instead of adding new ones and a delegation from the Junior Order asking that the state take over the four utiles from the Junior Order orghanage at Lexington to the stat tichway.

Brunswick county, from Supply to the South Carolina line, 20 miles. New Hanover from Wilmington to

Alamance and Chatham counties, Graham to Pittsboro, 25 miles. Alamance and Orange countees. Graham to Chappel Hill, 20 miles.
