FESTIVAL HALL ALMOST READY

San Francisco, Nov. 17-Within a week, Festival Hall, the last of the beautiful palaces of the Panama-Pacific International Exposition will be ready for the opening of the gates, February 20, 1915. With the Entshing of the building, work will begin on the installation of the mammoth pipe organ, and the echo organ, the latter to be placed at the top of the

Festival Hall will be an opera house and convention hall, and will be the meeting place of many of the national and international conventions which will meet in San Francisco in 1915. It is of French renaissance architecture, of the style of the seventeenth century, in harmony with the Palace of Horticulture, the Press building and other structures in the South Garden arena. It was modeled after the Theatre desBeaux Arts of Paris, while its details were studied from Le Grand Trianon. The dome which is the largest in America, is 221 feet high and 192 feet in diameter, exceeding that of the Palace of Horticulture by 40 feet in width and 36 feet in height.
