### HEALTH BOARD RE-ELECTS DRS. WEYHER & WOOTEN

The Board of Health has the responsibility of electing a County Superintendent of Health, or county physician, which office is now held by Dr. Albert DeKalb Parrott of the city. Formerly there were two physicians in the service of the board, one being the county physician and the other the "quarantine officer," The last-named was abolished several years ago at the instance of then Mayor W.
