GERMAN PLANES TO BE SHOWN IN LOAN DRIVE.

Richmond, April 12.—In the flying demonstrations arranged by the military aeronautics branch of the War Department to take place over American cities during the Victory Loan Campaign the German fokker plane will be a feature.
