NOTICE is hereby given,
that by an act of Congress enti-
tled "an act to provide addi-
tional revenues for defraying the
expenses of government, and
maintaining the public credit, by
duties on sugar, molasses, cotton

licences to retail wines, spirits,
liquors, and foreign merchan-
dize, and for increasing the
rates of postage," passed 2d Decem-
ber, 1814, an addition
