## TENNIS CABINET IS DOOMED

Washington Hostesses Are Dreading Coming White House Change. New York Evening Post.

What will become of Mr. Roosevelt "nice young men" if Mr. Bryan is elected? This problem is really giving serious concern to the pleasant, and notably the dinner giving, allens sojourning temporarily "in our midst." It seems an old sort of thing to werry about but Washington is an odd sort of place, unlike other cities in many of its aspects, and its residents, both permanent and fitting, have anxietles and responsibilities unknown to urban dwellers where the social population is less transient and changing than it is here.




