Boalt, an American writer, charg-ing that "the law of flight" had been applied to Mexican prisoners by an American naval officer, had been found without foundation by a court of inquiry. Secretary Daniels directed the investigation, while Secretary Garrison's order for the cancellation of Boalt's correspondent's credentials and his deportation was held in
