TO AID THE STATES IN AGRICULTURAL WORK

United States Government to Give Each State \$10,000 This Year.

Such a schedule has just been worked out by the United States Department of Agriculture. This fund is made available by the Smith-Lever bill providing for co-operative agricultural extension work between the states and the Department of Agriculture.

The United States Department of Agriculture is today engaged in sending individual official notices to 58,000 manufacturers that after May 1, 1915, the "Guaranteed Under the Pure Food and Drugs Act" label will be unnecessary.

But drug stores and apothecary shops may be kept open at all times for the sale of drugs and medicines, toilet articles and soaps, and such other merchandise as may be necessary in case of sickness or accident; provided this ordinance shall not apply to the sale of milk or ice at any time, nor to the delivery of ice cream prior to 10:45 o'clock a. m.

Allegation of the following ordinance: Be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of New Bern: Section 1. That Chapter 17 of the ordinances of the city be amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

Section 12. It shall be unlawful for any person afflicted with the smallpox to be in or go upon any street of the city. Whoever violates this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined the sum of fifty dollars or be imprisoned for thirty days.

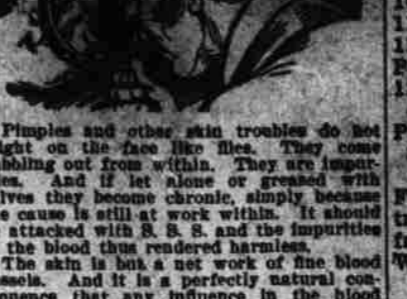
Be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of New Bern: Section 1. That Chapter 13 of the ordinances of the city be amended by striking out Section 3 thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Section 3. Any person, firm, or corporation who shall keep open any store or shop for the purpose of buying or selling merchandise or transacting business, or doing any work or labor of any kind on Sunday, except work of necessity or charity as is permitted by the general laws of the State, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall pay a fine of Ten Dollars.
