

## CTTY ORDINANCE.

Alderman Ellis moved the adoption of the following ordinance:

Be it ordeined by the Board of Aldermen of the City of New Bern;
Section 1. That chapter 4 of the ordinances of the city be amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

Section 40. All railroad companies maintaining a track or tracks across any street in the city shall between the rails of and on each side of such track or tracks either pave the width of such street or lay plank thereon in such manner as to permit whiches to cross without difficulty or oxosasive joiting. Whoever violates this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined ten dellars; and each day such track or tracks shall be maintained in violation thereof shall constitute a separate and distinct offense.
