ALEXANDER COLLIE

THE END OF A ONCE WELL KNOWN BLOCKADE RUNNER.

Well known in Wilmington, where his brother lived during the war...

About two weeks ago there died in obscurity in New York city, the famous blockade runner, Alexander Collie...

For nearly thirty-five years Alexander Collie had been a fugitive, and had concealed his identity under the name of George McNeal...

During the civil war, Wilmington, N. C., was noted for its blockade runners, and James Fort Fisher, commanded by Colonel William Lamb of Norfolk, Va., was the favorite gateway into the Cape Fear river...

They engaged the services of the best naval officers that could be obtained. Among them was Hewitt, a Victoria Cross man, who afterwards commanded the Queen's yacht, was Ambassador to Abyssinia...

They also had as his guests, ex-United States Senator J. M. Mason, the Confederate Commissioner to England, and Mr. Seward, Commissioner to France...

In Wilmington the firm leased one of the most elegant Southern homes, and a brother, William Collie, who resided there at the time, dispensed with lavish hands a like hospitality.

Many of the steamers of the firm were seized by the guns of Fort Fisher; and in some cases, where the vessels were lost, as in the case of the Venus, Concord and others, the cargoes were saved by the garrison of that Fort.
