Every teacher who wishes to stand examination for the five-year certificates and for the state high school teacher's certificate, should bear in mind that the date for the & examination is July 8th and 9th, 6 and that no other examination for & this purpose will be held during & the year. If a teacher fails to attend this examination, he will have to wait one year. The county superintendent cannot hold a second & examination for anybody. Ap- 6 plications for this examination & must be filed with the state superintendent not later than the 21st & of June. He will send blanks for this purpose or blanks may be had of the county superintendent. The state board grades all papers and issues certificates to the successful. For any additional information, teachers may apply to the county superintendent.


