WAS ROOSEVELT BOUGHT?

Sensational Allegations Made by Banker Before Senate Investigation Committee.

Washington, Nov. 28.—Wharton Barker, a retired banker of Philadelphia, sprung a sensation on the Senate committee on interstate commerce today when he alleged that a New York financier told him in 1904 that the financial interests would support Theodore Roosevelt for President because the latter had "made a bargain" with them "on the railroad question."

Mr. Barker's statement came in the midst of vigorous attack on the "money trust" in which he alleged also that President Roosevelt had been given the details of the impending panic of 1907 several months before it happened, but took no action to prevent it. He declared that the Aldrich currency plan was the handiwork, not of former Senator Aldrich, but of a Mr. Warburg of the banking firm of Kuhn, Loeb & Co. of New York, and that a fund of \$1,000,000 had been started to insure its adoption.

"Three or four weeks before the election in 1904," said Mr. Barker, "I was walking down Broadway when I met one of the most distinguished money kings in New York, a man now dead. He said to me: 'We are going to elect Roosevelt.' I expressed surprise and asked if he had given up the support of Parker. He said yes; that they had made a bargain with them."

Mr. Barker said the financial giant, whom he declined to name, told him that Roosevelt had "made a bargain on the railroad question." Mr. Barker continued:

"He is to holler all he wants to," he told me, "but by and by a railroad bill will be brought in by recommendation of the President cutting off rebates and free passes, which suits us who owns the railroads, permitting the railroads to make pooling arrangements and providing maximum rates."

The railroad man added, said Mr. Barker, that under the latter authority it would be possible to add from \$300,000,000 to \$400,000,000 to the total freight charges paid by the American public.

MUSCOVY DUCK IS PECULIAR

They Are Very Tame and Easier to Raise Than Chickens—Make Excellent Fowl for the Table.

To appreciate the beauty of Muscovy ducks it is necessary to see them. There are two varieties, the colored and the white. The colored may be either blue, black, green or fawn, but whichever shade they chance to be they are lustrous and shiny, and the dark coloring is relieved by underwings and sides of snowy white, says the Prairie Farmer. They have scarlet faces all around their eyes down to their bills; on their heads is a crescent of feathers that lays flat until the bird is excited or angry, then those short, soft feathers stand up straight, forming a cap. The hen duck is about the size of a Pekin, dainty and very beautiful. The drake is extremely large, weighing when matured between ten and twelve pounds. The white Muscovies are the same as the colored excepting that they are entirely white. The peculiarities of the Muscovies are numerous and interesting. They never quack, but make a queer husky, hissing sound. Both ducks and drakes fly like pigeons, but the ducks being of lighter weight, can fly a greater distance. They will rise from the barnyard, circle a forty-acre field and finally alight in almost the same spot from which they started. They roost on barns and other high places. The ducks are splendid layers. They usually build their nests in lofts and in the high boxes in the henhouse.
