State News.

North Carolina, according to the census figures, is the second State in the union in the production of yarns. Massachusetts leads with 523,000,000 yards and North Carolina comes second with 308,000,000 yards.

Senator Overman has selected the location for the Vance statue in statuary hall in Washington. It will be placed next to that of Robert E. Lee, and near that of Dr. J. L. M. Curry, of Alabama, who spent much of his time in North Carolina.

The Hon. Josephus Daniels has been made chairman of the delegation from the South Atlantic States to make the necessary arrangements for holding the national convention at Baltimore. All who want a ticket to the convention hall can write Mr. Daniels at Raleigh.

The United Growers of Western North Carolina, Inc., has just been chartered with \$100,000 capital, authorized and \$3,000 subscribed for by W. H. Horton, L. M. Townsend and others, for handling all sorts of farm produce, operating canneries and packhouses and other equipment for taking care of and marketing produce of that section.

The Sanford Express hears that citizens of certain territory in Harnett county petitioned for an election on the stock law. The election was ordered and the registration books kept open according to law. Only one man registered and on the day of election not a single vote was cast for or against the proposition.

The special committee consisting of Col. J. Bryan Grimes, Gen. J. S. Carr, president, F. P. Venable, Dr. Herty and Colonel Benahan Cameron has awarded the contract for splendid new dormitories at the University of North Carolina to J. G. Lawrence & Sons of Durham. The plans are after the most approved sectional design for dormitories now provided at most of the great modern universities of the country.

In Robeson County Superior Court last week injunction proceedings were brought by Frank Gough against the sheriff of the county to restrain the sheriff of Robeson from collecting taxes upon the increased valuation of property made by the board of county commissioners. The order also restrains him from collecting more than \$2 poll tax. Affixed by the board the poll tax is \$2.85. This case will be watched with considerable interest by the whole State.

Already the management of the Roman Catholic Orphanage at Raleigh is planning to rebuild the buildings destroyed by fire, entailing a loss of \$12,000. The buildings were a dormitory, old auditorium and school building, laundry, barn and stables. The buildings burned were all old and fortunately the new brick dormitory administration building and chapel were uninjured so that the work of the institution will go right on, somewhat crowded but with full corps of faculty and children pending the erection of larger and better buildings for those burned.

The naval year book, issued under the auspices of the Senate committee on foreign relations, gives the United States second place among the naval powers, this government having 37 battleships, one more than Germany. In armoured cruisers Germany has 14 and the United States 12. The combined tonnage of battleships and cruisers shows the United States has 787,638 tons and Germany 768,241.
