Fifty-nine tracts are comprised in the new acquisitions, the largest beg in "Kilkenny purchase area," New Hampshire and covering are in the White Mountains, making the total acquired there 698,086Smaller tracts were purchased in the Southern Appalachian Mountains, the largest total on any area being that of 7,678 acres in Tranylvania County, North Carulina, n the Pisgah Forest. Other tracts McDowell Counties, North Caroina, on the Boone, Nantahala and Mount Mitchell areas, aggregate 1,870 acres.
