Road of Portable Section Confronted by the task of building highway over a desert of constantly shifting sands, which in a few years might cover and render useless a road-bed of macadam or concrete, the Calibed of macadam or concrete, the Call-fornia highway commission has intro-duced a type of paving which is porta-ble, so that it can be easily moved to conform to the changing topography of the country. The Popular Mechanics Magazine describes the paving, which is made of plank, built in sections twelve feet long and eight feet wide, and hauled by wagons to the points where it is needed. This unusual thor-oughfare extends six miles across a oughfare extends six miles across a portion of the desert lying between Yuma, Ariz., and Holtville, Cal. The plank sections are built on 4 by 6 inch stringers. The units were bound to gether by iron strips placed over rows of spikes, one on either side and one along the center of the road. Round heated bolts running through the planks and the stringers were used to hold the strips down. The latter, in addition to joining the units together, keep the spikes from working out.


