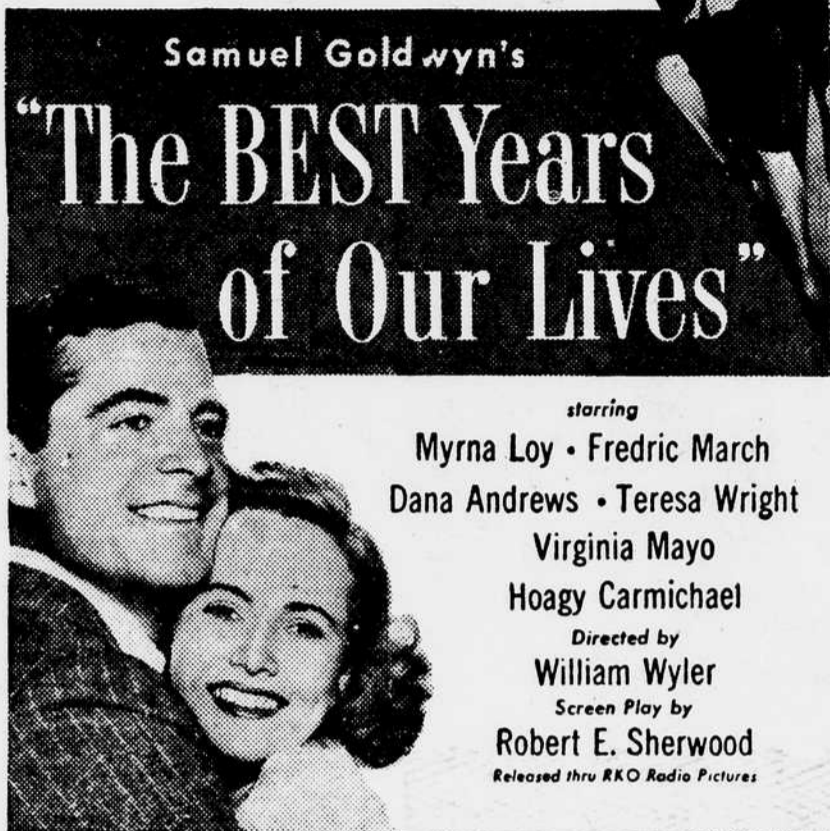

Sewell Brown, who has been ill at his home at Ashford for the past few days, was reported improving yesterday.

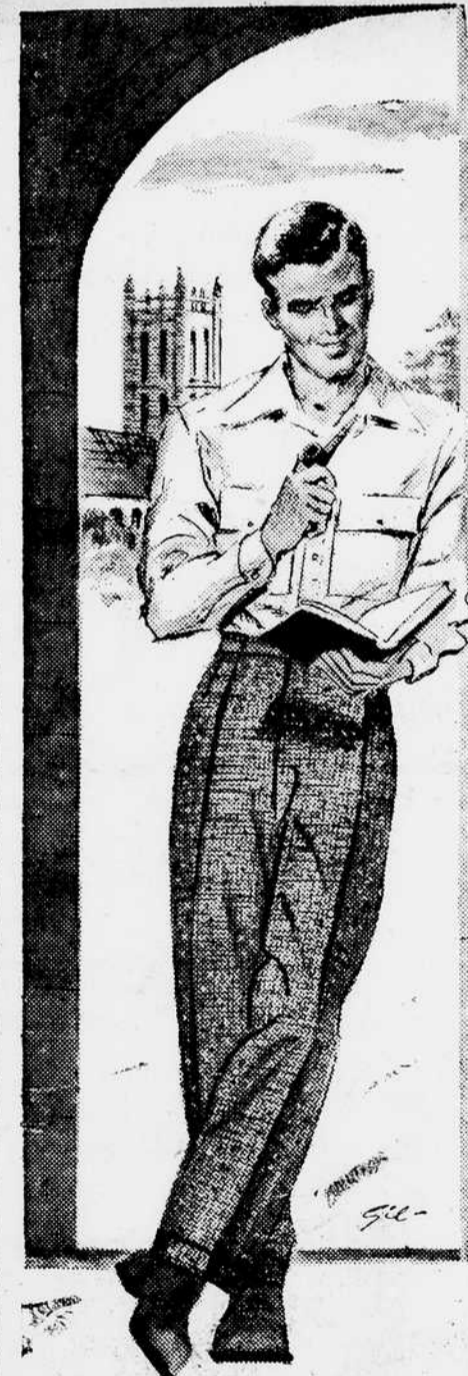
Miss Margaret Westmoreland has returned to her home here after attending summer school at the University of North Carolina.
