- ½ cup apricot pulp ¼ cup granulated sugar
- ½ teaspoon lemon extract 1/4 cup chopped nut meats
- 3 egg whites

1/4 teaspoon cream of tarter 2 tablespoons powdered sugar

Add granulated sugar and lemon extract to prunes and apricots and beat until sugar is thoroughly dissolved. Add nuts. Sprinkle egg whites with cream of tarter and beat until stiff. Add powdered sugar and continue beating until sugar is blended with egg whites. Fold the beaten whites into the fruit mixture and place in a greased baking dish. Set baking dish in a pan of hot water and bake in moderate oven for about 40 minutes or until firm. Serve with cream or soft custard.


