

S. 242 (bush) Siera (Pole); Henderson-(Bush); Challenger (Pole) Fordhook type; Cauliflower-early snowball; super-snowball; sweet corngolden cross bantam (yellow), Ioana (yellow), Stonewall evergreen, Hybrid (white); okra — Louisana green velvet; Ciemson Spineless; English peas-Thomas Laxton, Progress, Wando; blackberries-Eldarado, Common Wild.

Blueberries-Rancocas, Scammell Jersey, Stanley, Common Wild; grapes-scuppernong (white), Topsial, (white), hunt, (black); peaches-Dixigem (early) golden; Jubilee (midseason); Elberta (late); Hale (late); Raspberries-Latham (red), Dixie (red), Cumberland (black); strawberries - Premier, Blakemore, Midland, Tenn. Supreme; Apples-York; Stayman, Rome beauty; Dewberries-Young; Boysenberry.


