### New Lilies and New Ways To Plant Them This Fall

Japanese lily bulbs will be back in full supply this fall, and with them new American varieties, so that lily fanciers may choose from a list larger than ever before available, to plant for next summer's

Fall planting is best, because most lily bulbs available in the spring were dug the previous fall, and spent the winter in cold storage. It is much better for them to be in the soil of your garden, where they can start spring growth as soon as the frost has left.

Plant breeders in this country have been working on lilies, and offer several hybrid types, which are claimed to be more adaptable to garden environment than older varieties, which are species, or wild forms, gathered in their native homes, and transferred to gardens without change. Those which have survived and can be grown with reasonable care in average garden soil
