# MANY EXTRA HOLE CONTBSTS 

# Match Play Rounds of the Annual Spring 

 Tourney Very Fast.THonnter Field in Evenly Matched and Keen Play Tilen Through out All Divinions.


XTRA hole contests were the feature of the fourth annual spring :tournament, and they ran through all divisions, from the first to the seventh, for no field here has been more evenly matched. Naturally interest centered in the first division, but play was equally close in the others, notably the fourth, with two nineteen-hole matches in the semi-final round and very few matches throughout that were won with more liberal margins than "two and one."

At the head of the line was the PorterLard twenty-hole battle, following close upon Mr. Porter's defeat of Mr. O. P. Clay of the Cleveland Country Club, on the nineteenth green; J. V. Hurd of the Pittsburg Country Club, playing an extra hole match with Dr. G. J. Mckee of Oakmont, in the fourth division, G. J. Loveley of Brae Burn, a similar match with J. D. Miller of Mohawk, in the fifth, and II. C. Fitzgerald of Mohawk, another with Mr. Miller in the consolation, and G. B. Yerkes of Detroit, winning from W.S. Benson of Yountakah, on the extra hole in the consolation of the seventh and last flight.
