MOONLIGHT PHOTOGRAPHY

SPECIAL attention is called to the half tone reproduction of a moonlight photograph taken by Mr. Tyler L. Redfield, which appears in connection with this article, the picture showing the "Dartmouth", the private residence of Mr. Gilbert N. McMillan, with the camera located directly in front of the Plymouth, where Mr. Redfield is spending the winter.

The picture was made upon the night of the third of February when the moon was at its full and the exposure of one hour's duration, from nine to ten. An especially novel feature is the effect produced by the electric porch light and the light in the rear window. But for these one might be led to believe that the picture was taken in the day time. The camera used was a folding kodak with a special lens.

Mr. Redfield is looking forward with interest to future experiments in this line and he anticipates even more successful results, believing that the conditions such as exist here are not to be found elsewhere. Owing to the length of exposure necessary the best results are obtained when the moon is directly overhead, thus avoiding moving shadows.

third sixteen; Treasurer's cup to winner of first sixteen; Governor's cup to winner of second sixteen; Secretary's cup to winner of fourth sixteen; Captain's cup to winner of fifth sixteen; Club's cup to winner of sixth sixteen; sterling cups to first division runner-up and consolation division winner; silver medals to division runners-up and consolation division winners in the second, third, fourth, fifth and sixth divisions.

MARCH 24, 25, 26, 27—Seventh Annual United North and South Amateur Championship for Women—Best sixteen scores to qualify, eighteen holes to be played on the morning of each day. Gold medal for the best qualification score; Championship cup to the winner and sterling cups to the runner-up and consolation division winner.

MARCH 29, 30, 31, APRIL 1—Ninth Annual United North and South Amateur Championship—Qualifying round and finals, thirty-six holes. Gold medal for best qualification score; Championship cup to winner of first sixteen; President's cup to winner of second sixteen; Governor's cup to winner of third sixteen; Secretary's cup to winner of fourth sixteen; Treasurer's cup to winner of fifth sixteen; Captain's cup to winner of sixth sixteen; sterling cups to division runners-up and consolation division

winners in all divisions.

APRIL 3—Ninth Annual United North and South Open Championship—Thirty-six holes medal play; amateurs winning to receive equivalent to their prize in plate. First prize \$100 and Championship gold medal; second, \$50; third, \$25.

APRIL 15, 16, 17—First Annual Mid-April Tournament—Qualifying round and finals, eighteen holes. Sterling cup for best qualification score; President's cup to winner of first sixteen; Governor's cup to winner of second sixteen; silver medals to division runners-up and consolation division winners in both divisions.

TENNIS TOURNAMENTS.

MARCH 6—Women's singles for spring cup.
MARCH 15, 16, 17—Championship men's and women's single and mixed doubles for gold medals.

TRAP SHOOTING TOURNAMENTS.

FEB. 1 TO MARCH 29—Weekly handicap tournament for sterling cup.
GOLD MEDAL for four best scores made during the season, winner to have shot at not less than 800 targets.

PISTOL TOURNAMENTS.

MARCH 22-27—Annual Club Championship for gold medals for men and women. U. S. R. A. State Championship late in March; Association medals for prizes.
