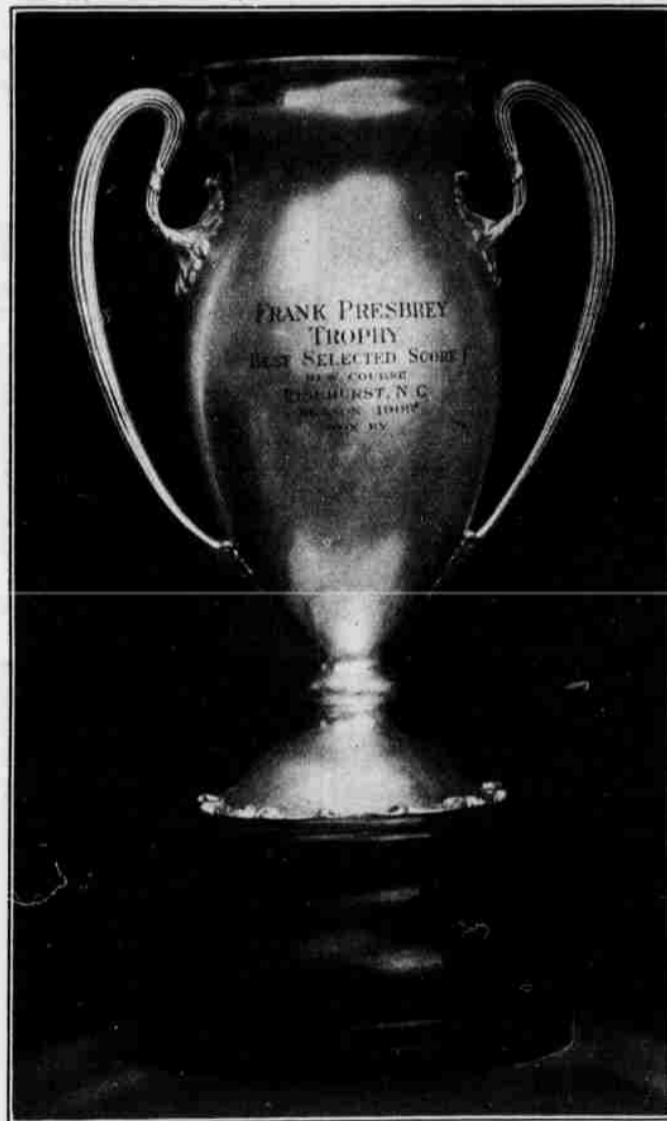

ANNOUNCEMENT was made Wednesday of the results of the competition for the "Frank Presbrey selected score trophy" which has been in effect since January 10th and which ended April 10th; D. J. Coffey of Boston, J. D. Foot of Rye, and C. L. Becker of Boston, leading with scores of fifty-six, fifty-seven and sixty.

Mr. Foot's total was secured in twenty-seven rounds, Mr. Becker's in twenty-five, Mr. Gardner's in nineteen, Mr. Blackburn's in twenty-three, Mr. Robeson's in thirty-two, and Mr. Ormsbee's in twenty-eight.

Details of arrangements were in the hands of a committee including H. W. Ormsbee, W. L. Hurd and Donald Ross and entries were made in a book especially prepared for the purpose; the cards printed above representing the best score made on each of the eighteen holes.
