HE first of the equestrian Gymkhana's is announced for Tuesday afternoon next, the program varied and entertaining
withevents for all classes of riders. Never has the interest been more general, as is evinced by the fact

that a number have signified their intention of giving cups; the first of these presented by Mrs. Burrage, in the childrens' class. Arrangements have also been made for preliminary practise.
The program in full with descriptive matter on the various events, follows :
Potato Race-Six potatoes to be transferred from one end of the course to the other, one at a time, on the point of a lance.

Tilting at Rings-Four rings are to be suspended in a line and are to be carried away by lance at a gallop, one point for a touch, two for a carry, pace to count.

SCARF RACE-A lady and gentleman
holding a scarf between them race to a point and back.
V. C. Race-Competitors ride to a certain point, pick up a dummy figure and return to starting point. Handicap will be given as to how the dummies may be picked up, so as to equalize the ladies chances.

Doughnut Race-Competitors race to a given point, eat a suspended doughnut without using hands, and return.

Riding Tandem-Ride one horse driving another in front. Style and horsemanship only to count.
Jev du Ruban-Two riders try to remove a ribbon from the shoulder of a third. The riders taking the ribbon may only use the hand furthest from the rider carrying the ribbon. Each of the three may in turn carry the ribbons two minutes for each heat.
