

GOLF STRANGE VAGARIES

Match Rounds of St. Valentine's Tourney Provide Interesting Study



THE remarkable feature of the match play rounds of the Annual St. Valentine's Golf tournament was the absence of close competition, frequently commented upon because of the numerous ties which bunched the field in qualification. In all divisions preliminary play advanced few players beyond the fifteenth green and very few pairs overran the eighteenth. There were some surprises, however, and a reward in Saturday's final rounds with their keen competition. A study of the summary attached with knowledge of the games of the players which many of the readers possess, furnishes an interesting basis for comparison illustrating as it does golf's strange vagaries.

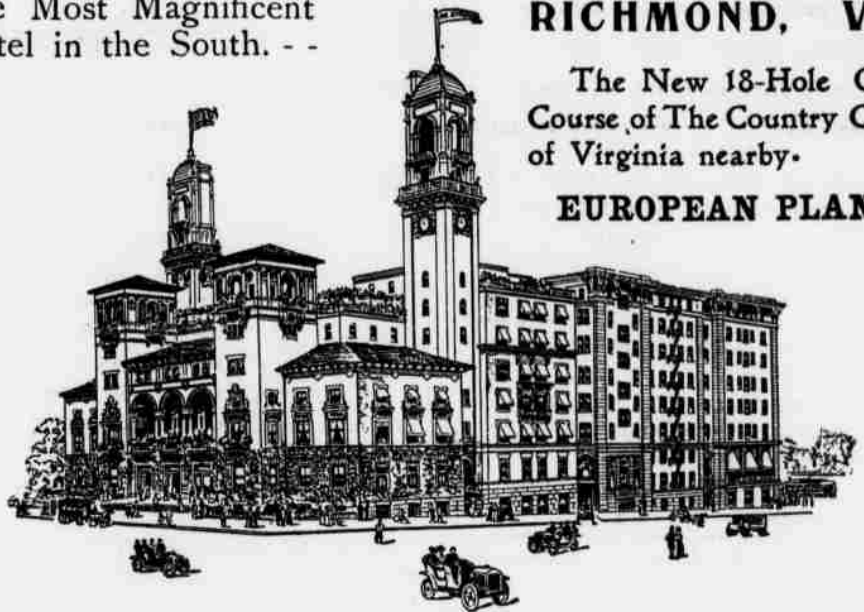
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
