Eighty-eight Heads Advertising Golf Tourney Qualification Round



EIGHTY-EIGHT won the qualification trophy for R. M. Purves of Woodland in the qualification round of the Advertising Golf Tournament. In second and third positions, W. J. Macdonald of Calumet and George C. Dutton of Belmont scored ninety-two and ninety-three, a quadruple tie at one hundred and one marking the limit of admission to the first division, William C. Freeman of Dyker Meadow losing the play-off. ¶ One hundred and thirty-seven was the top-notch card which concluded the sixth and last flight. Play was on No. 2 course, and "gentle zephyrs" toying with the balls on the putting-greens, added what, is variously estimated at from six to ten strokes to the cards. ¶ The scores:
