It costs a dollar to do this and money is scarce. ¶ Drum Major Hamilton has long been a nature communer and he loves golf for golf's sake. This contribution, therefore, he feels is but a small tribute to art in which man's joy is always in his work.

Briefly, Composer Hamilton has combined in these, his masterpieces, nature's symphonies with just enough contrast to give them a Wagnerian character; morn's faint matin chant, midday's wild alarm, night's sweet requiem; the roar of town, the song of country; the gladness of greeting, the pain of parting; every line throbbing with living, vibrant, exultant life. ¶ Pen can but suggest, Mr. Hamilton's compositions must be heard to be appreciated.

The *ensemble* includes five drums and an equal number of fifes, "musical"

gridirons, toasters, teapots, pans and so forth. Each member of the band is a soloist in his disregard for others; the uniform "Made in the United States" tam-o-shantas, and "glad to get back smiles!"
