

"Any person who becomes ineligible by reason of this bylaw may be reinstated by giving to the Executive Committee of this association satisfactory evidence of meriting such reinstatement. No occurrence prior to January 8, 1915, shall affect the status of any person who was in good standing as an amateur on

As if to prevent arguments on the forehas compiled what it defines as five distinct violations, as follows:


First. Playing or teaching the game of golf for pay. This includes accepting traveling or living expenses for playing over a course or for participating in a golf tournament, contest or exhibition.

clubs, golf balls or other articles for pay. Third. Serving, after reaching the age of sixteen, as caddie, caddie master or greenkeeper

for hire. Fourth. Lending one's name or likeness for the advertisement or sale of anything except as

a dealer, manufacturer or inventor thereof in the usual course of business. Fifth. Permitting one's name to be adver-

tised or published for pay as the author of books or articles on golf which one is not actually the author.

# Thought Transference Works Havoc With Portly Caruso's Drive




