Events of the past year will be vividly brought to mind during the evening.

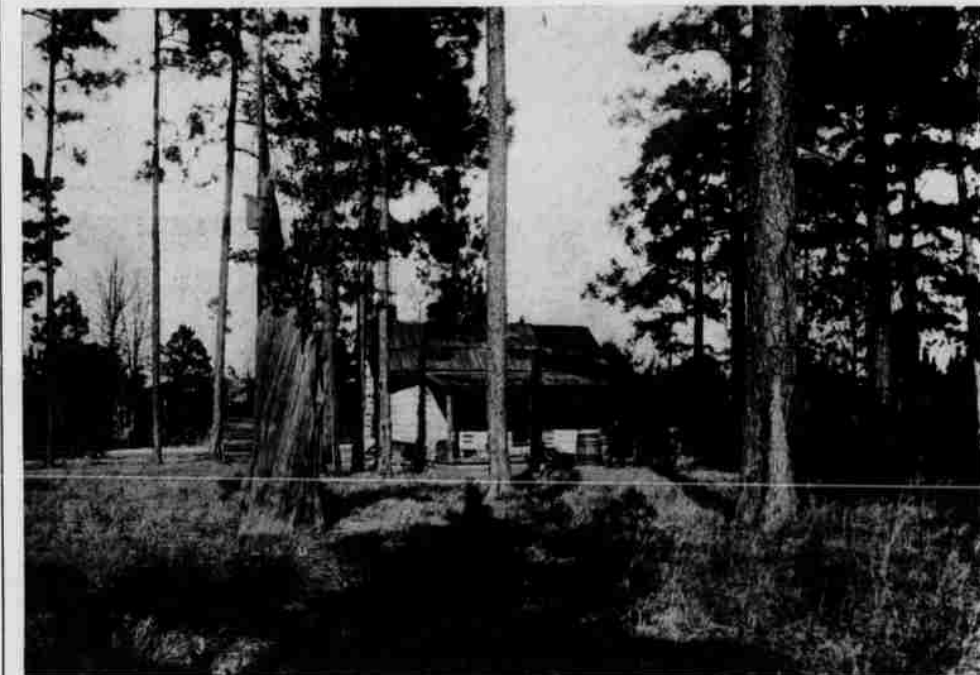

The size of the dining room and other matters that must be taken into account make it necessary to limit the attendance to members absolutely, and we ask all members to give us their co-operation in this.

The delay is emphatically not due to a lack of enthusiasm or recruits.
