There are 3,000 varieties that could be planted—and only twelve that in Mr. Miller's opinion would do at all.

What Did You Do?

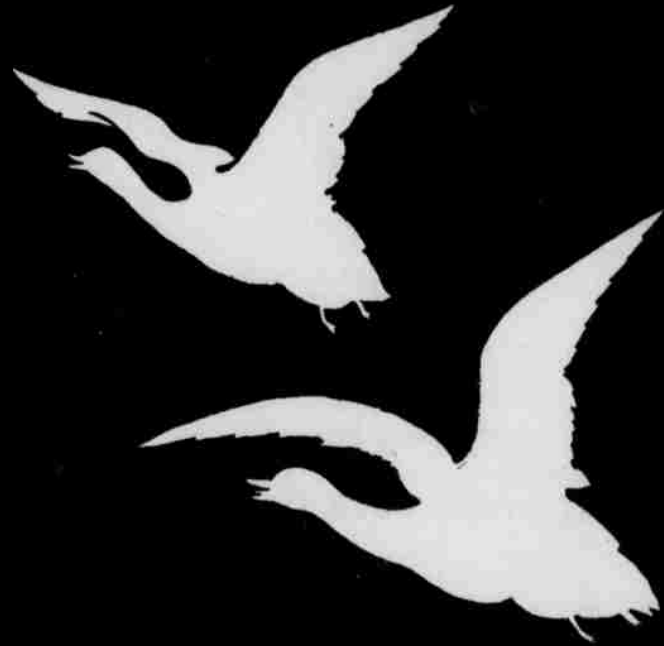
Did you give him a lift? He's a brother of Man
