Mr. Draper has been a director of the Conway Bank for 34 years. Still driving at 90, he attends the weekly meetings regularly.

PENDLETON - The Robert's Chapel 4-H Club met in regular session Sunday afternoon with the president, Wayne Woodard, presiding.

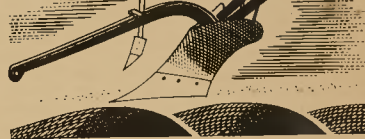
Betty Anne Edwards gave a demonstration of the use of "Proper Foods." She used colorful charts to explain her demonstration.
