JACKSON — The Northampton County Unit of the North Carolina Education Association met in the auditorium of Jackson Elementary School February 9 at four o'clock.


The meeting was called to order by the president, Mrs. Mabel Rogers of Seaboard.

## Conway Firm Offers New Bulk Fertilizer

CONWAY — A. W. Chandler, district manager for Armour Agricultural Chemical Company in Greensboro announced today that Armour's new fertilizer and chemical crop protection facilities at Conway have been completed.

Chandler indicated the new facilities are a part of Armour's multi-million dollar expansion program in the farm chemical and fertilizer field.

With the new bulk - loading equipment the Conway plant can now handle "double the fertilizer load" it could through bag distribution, according to Guy Revelle, field representative for Armour in the area.

Now comments Revelle, "we can handle 300 tons of fertilizer in a single day."

Chandler said that Armour is holding open house on Wednesday, February 23, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., and invites all residents to visit with them and participate in the drawings for the many door prizes being offered.

Prior to the installation of bins and equipment for the wholesale handling of fertilizer, all fertilizer was sold in bags of various weights.

"We will handle about 60 per cent of our fertilizer in bulk immediately," says Revelle, "and between 75-80 per cent of the fertilizer sold will be bulk in the
