A. P. O. & 91, Feb. 3rd.

Dear Brother:—
This leaves me well. Am off on a 11-day furlough at Aix-les-Baine, France. Very cold here; snows most every day; very deep on mountains in sight of us.
Have not been back with my company very long. Was in a hospital three months, but got out well. Was wounded in three places and was lucky to get out alive. I was in Germany 36 days, and 26 days in a German hospital; was treated well by the German doctors; the worst part was I got little to eat.
Think I killed my part of the Huns in the fight I was in. Was under fire for two days and one night. Glad I got out alive, and hope we'll soon come home. Have had a good rest here and plenty of good things to eat. Will rejoin my company the 5th, my furlough expiring then.
