BAKED BANANAS.—Allow one tablespoonful of sugar and one teaspoonful of hot water for each banana.

BANANA-CREAM PUDDING.—Melt 1 cup of sugar in 1 pint of hot milk. Mix two tablespoons corn-starch with cold milk, stir it into the boiling milk, and cook 15 minutes.

BANANA CREAM.—Mash four ripe bananas in a bowl and beat them with the egg beater till they are light.
