Weldon Jaycees Hear Reavis

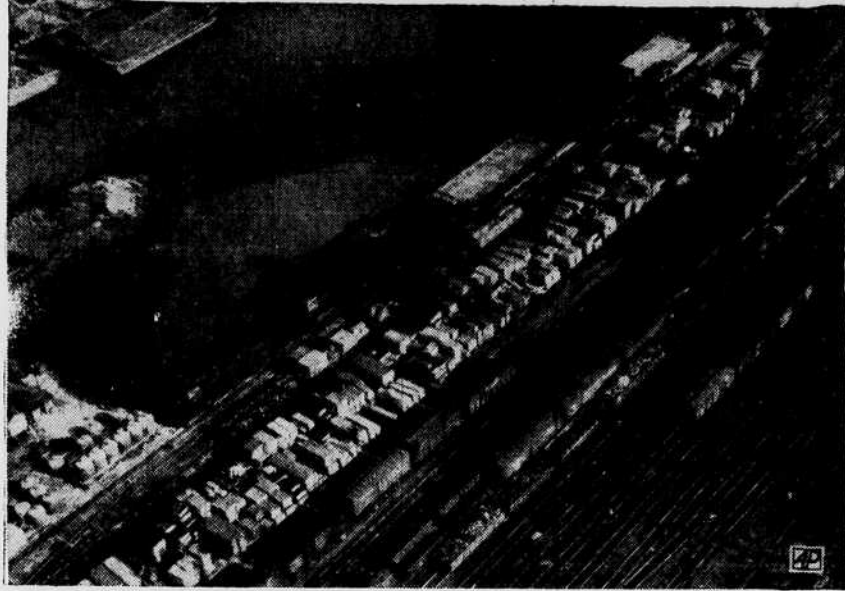
Weldon.—A regular meeting of the Weldon Junior Chamber of Commerce was held Thursday night at the Scout Hut with President Wick Draeger presiding.
