Roaches have a way of mak-ing themselves at home even in the cleanest homes. They destroy food, damage fabries and spread disease. Usually they are found in the kitchen and bathrooms, or brown banded roaches may be found any where in the house. Of-

ten times these roaches find their way into your kitchen in the grocery bag. To control roaches, use in-secticides containing Diazinon. Spray the baseboards, sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators and any other place that roaches seem to hide. Remove all of your dishes and spray cupboards. You can replace the dishes after the spray is dry. It is best to use the chemical again in two weeks


