

UNABLE TO AGREE IN THE HUFF CASE

Although the jury in the case in which John Huff is charged with the murder of E. C. McConnell had had the case under consideration since Saturday evening, when court convened this morning just after ten o'clock and the jury filed in Judge Bragaw was told that the members had been unable to agree. The difference was eight to four, he was told. Judge Bragaw stated that the case had already cost the county a great deal of money and he thought they should consider it longer to see if an agreement cannot be reached. Certain members of the jury then asked to hear the deposition of people in South Carolina concerning their acquaintance with the prisoner and again went out. Judge Bragaw said he would not dismiss court for any stated time but would return to the court house when notified that the jury had agreed. He would have them consider the case before declaring a mistrial, in the event he was convinced an agreement was impossible.
