## ROAD WORK BEEINS.

Col. Wonders, United States Gov ernment Road Engineer, of Wash ington, is in the city, and accom panied by the road trustees of Syl va township, has carefully gon over the roads from Sylva to Cul lowhee and from Sylva to the Scott Creek township line. He secured samples of rock and other road ma terial that is easily accessible and has sent them to the road depart ment to be analyzed in order that ment to be analyzed in order tha here may be no mistake made in the material to be used in the con struction of the first improved road in Jackson county. It was the in tention of the road trustees to be gin the surveying of the routes for these roads, Tuesday. However, on account ot the heavy rains it was impossible to do so, but the surveyors will start their work this week and the work will be done as rapid ly as possible.
The law, providing for this work as passed by the last General As sembly, also provides in section 20 "That the provisions in this ac shall apply in all their force and effect to any township in Jackson county not especially named herein upon petition signed by a majority of the qualified voters of such township, and the board of county commissioners of Jackson county shal upon receiving such petetion, appoint a board of road trustees for such township aforesaid of not less than five members (not more than four shall be chosen from any one political party) who shall organjze and proceed to carry out the provisions of this act as is provided for the townships named herein, Provided, that the bond issue for any further townships coming under the provisions of this ac shall not exceed the sum of thirty thousand dollars." The section of good roads act gives any township in the county the prerogative of petitioning the county commissioners, issuing township road bonds and constructing improved roads. What township will be the first to take advantage of this opportunity and join the good roads movement that is sweeping over North Carolina?
