

The Commissioners of Jackson County have made arrangements with the North Carolina Board of Health whereby everyone in the County will be given for a limited time only, an opportunity to be treated free by a State Specialist for the Hook-worm Disease, or any other disease due to intestiant parasites.

EXAMINATION, TREATMENT, MEDICINE AND ALL FURNISHED ABSOLUTELY FREE.

One-third of the people have this disease. hence the County is giving you this opportunity to become not only a useful but a healthy citizen. The State Physicians with their Microscopists will appear at the following points on the days and dates mentioned below:

QUALLA -or Shool Creek--Tuesday, August 12th, 26th and September 9th. WILMOT--Tuesday August 19th and September 2nd. SYLVA--Wed. August 13th and Thursday 21st, Wednesday 27th and September 10th. WEBSTER--Thursday, August 14th and Wednesday 20th and September 3rd. SAVANNAH--Thursday August 28th and September 4th and 11th. CULLOWHEE--Friday, August 15th 29th and September 12th. TUCKASEIGEE--Friday August 22nd and September 5th. GLENVILLE--Saturday August 16th, 30th and September 13th. CASHIER'S VALLEY--Saturday, August 23rd and September 6th.

Remember this is for a limited time only, for at the end of five weeks these free medical dispensaries will move to another County.

Everyone should visit their nearest Dispensary and be examined. It costs nothing. All paid for by your State and County.

No one, regardless of their age, sex, social standing, know, unless they have had this examination made, that they are not infected. All of us are at all times exposed to the causes that give rise to these diseases. If the examination proves that we are not infected with any of the intestinal parasites then the satisfaction of knowing this is certainly worth the trouble we have gone to to find out. If on the other hand, the examination does show that we are infected with the Hookworm, Tape worms, Eel 1. worms, or any of the intestinal parasites, then the medicines that will be given you FREE by these State physicians will not only cure every case but bring about a wonderful improvement in both your health end feelings.

HOW TO BE EXAMINED.

Call at your nearest drug store or country store, and secure some of our free containers, one for each member of your family. Write plainly on the lable of the container's the name and age of the applicant to be examined. Bring each of these a very small portion of the bowel movement, to the nearest dispensary on the next dispensary day. These specimens will be examined by one of the State laboratory men with the microscope, and, if they show any infection of intestinal parasites will then be given you free of charge.

REMEMBER that there is no necessity of having each member of the family to visit fhe dispensary in order to be examined, as it is only necessary to bring this small of specimen of the bowel movement.

EVERYONE however, is cordially invited to the dispensary to hear the lectures about these diseases and see the interesting exhibits that will be opened at each point.

REMEMBER that the dispensaries will open at these points, regardless of the weather, on the dates mentioned. They will be open at 10 and close at 3. Anyone in the town can tell you the building in which they are located.

During the past twelve months over 200,000 people have been examined in North Carolina for this disease, while more than 89,000 have been treated and cured.
