ANTI-HOG CHOLERA SERUM.

The North Carolina Department of Agriculture has for the past three years prepared and distributed to the farmers of this State anti-hog cholera serum at cost of production.

This serum is used as a preventive for hog cholera, and if injected before the hogs show any signs of cholera, it will prevent them from developing a case of cholera, even if they are exposed. It is not claimed for this serum that it will cure a case of cholera, as it is a preventive and not a curative measure.

We began the preparation of this serum in a very limited way and have found that it has met with uniformly good results. The demand for it has increased until it was impossible to meet the demands at the plant where we first began the work. In order to be in a position to meet all demands made by the farmers of this State for the serum, we have built and equipped a large new serum plant which will be used exclusively for preparing anti-hog cholera serum.
