



**SOUTHERN RAILWAY NEW TRADEMARK**

The Southern Railway Company has adopted a new and attractive trade mark as shown above. The design "SR" is symbolic to the name of the road and the wording "The Southern Serves the South" is suggestive of the many lines operated by the Southern Railway throughout all of the states south of the Ohio and Potomac and east of the Mississippi rivers.

There is hardly a city or town of importance throughout the entire South that is not connected with the balance of the South, either directly by the Southern Railway's own trains or by sleeping car lines over other roads in connection with Southern Railway, via some adjacent junction point.

On this account the title "The Southern Serves the South" was adopted as being appropriate.

Southern Railway spends about \$2,000,000.00 a year in advertising and a great deal of this advertising is done in the Northern, Eastern and Western sections of the country so as to attract people into the South, and on all of this advertising matter this trade mark will appear hereafter.

Washington, D. C., August 28.—The results of operation of Southern Railway Company for the months of July, 1915 and 1914, exclusive of interest, rentals and other income charges, were announced by Comptroller A. H. Plant today as follows:

Gross Revenue, July, 1915, \$5,211,635; July, 1914, \$5,705,119; decrease \$493,484 or 8.65 per cent.

Operating Expenses, Taxes and Uncollectible Railway Revenue, July, 1915, \$3,893,988; July, 1914, \$4,535,647; decrease \$641,659 or 14.15 per cent.

Operating Income, July, 1915, \$1,317,647; July 1914, \$1,169,472; increase \$148,175 or 12.67 per cent.

In addition to the foregoing operating expenses, the company spent during the month, for improvements to its roadway and structures, \$470,501.97, as against \$291,692.62 for July 1914, an increase of \$178,809.35.

Operating income as shown above represents the amount remaining after the payment of only those expenses incurred in the actual operation of the railway and of taxes, and takes no account of the charges for hire of equipment, rental of leased lines, terminals, and other facilities, and interest on funded debt (bonds), all of which costs are charged against operating income.
