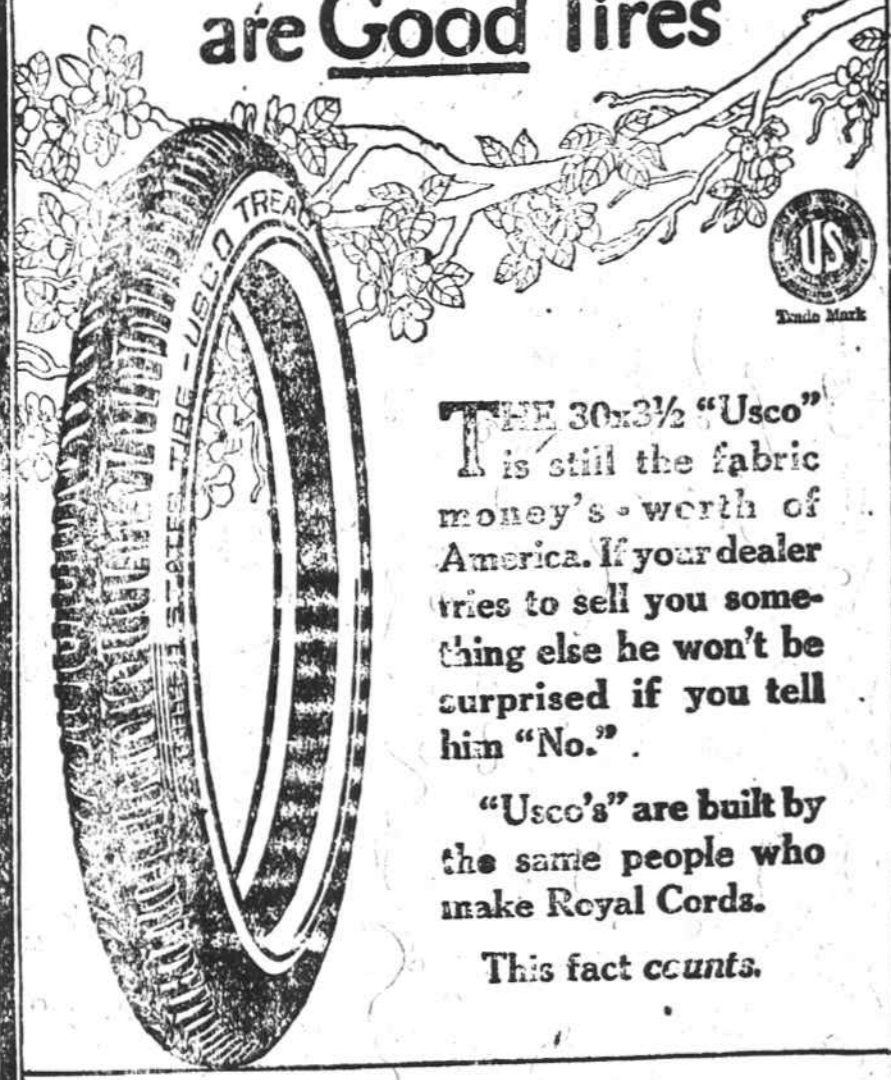

### NORTH CAROLINA, JACKSON COUNTY.

#### NOTICE TO TEACHERS

I wish to call attention to Article VII, Section 160, of the Public School Laws, enacted by the General Assembly of 1923, relative to making application for position as teacher. This law is as follows:

"It is the duty of teachers in making application for a position to teach, first, to file application with the Superintendent, stating the kind and the number of the certificate held, when the certificate expires, experience in teaching, the position last held, and a statement that applicant has no contagious disease. The applicant should also state that the applicant, if elected will not break the contract without the approval of the Superintendent who approved the contract without giving, at least, thirty days notice, and that he or she will observe the rules and regulations adopted by the Board of Trasees or the County Board of Education, under whose jurisdiction she is employed to teach."

All teachers desiring to teach in this county this year are requested to file in the office of the County Board of Education, an application containing the above data. I have on hand a full supply of blanks and urge that all teachers and prospective teachers get these blanks as early as possible and file with me.
