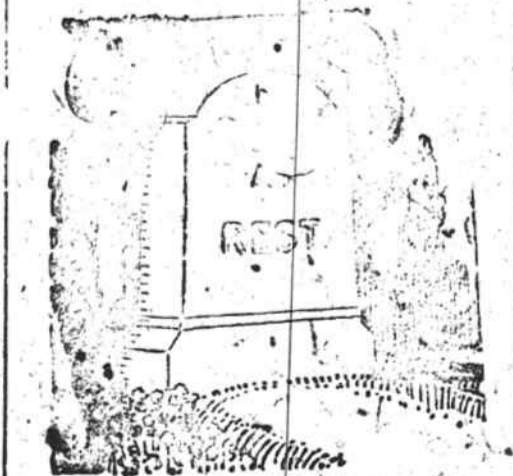
NOTICE OF SALE UNDER DEED IN TRUST
