 "Curling" is an ancient game originating in Scotland, known to have existed previous to 1600. It is played on the ice with large, smooth stones of hemispherical form, to which are attached iron or wooden handles. The first club formed in the United States was at Pontiac, Mich., 1842. "Skip" is the name of the player, one on each side, under whose direction the ice is swept, this being done in a special manner. "Bonspiel" is the name for curling matches with picked players.

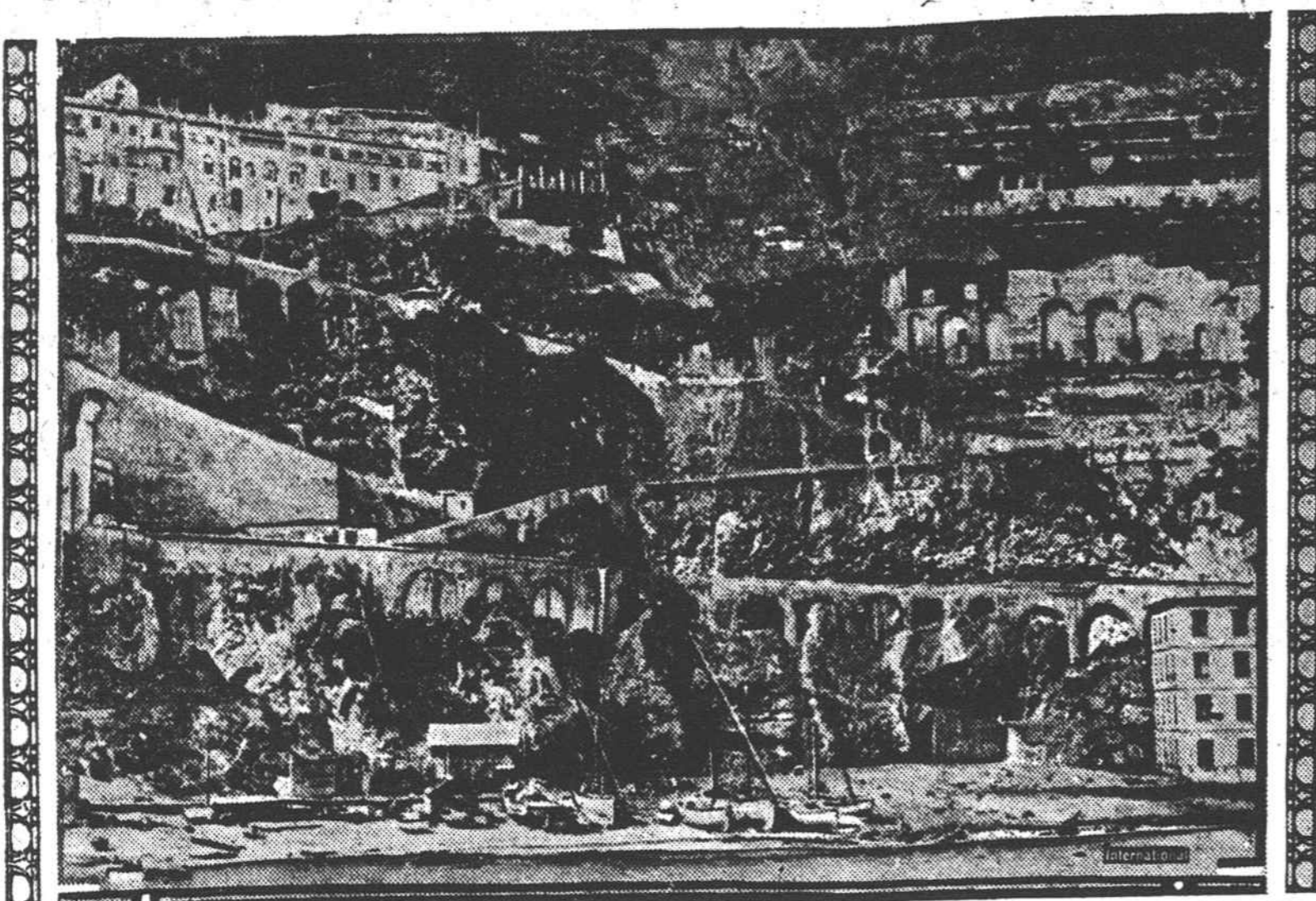

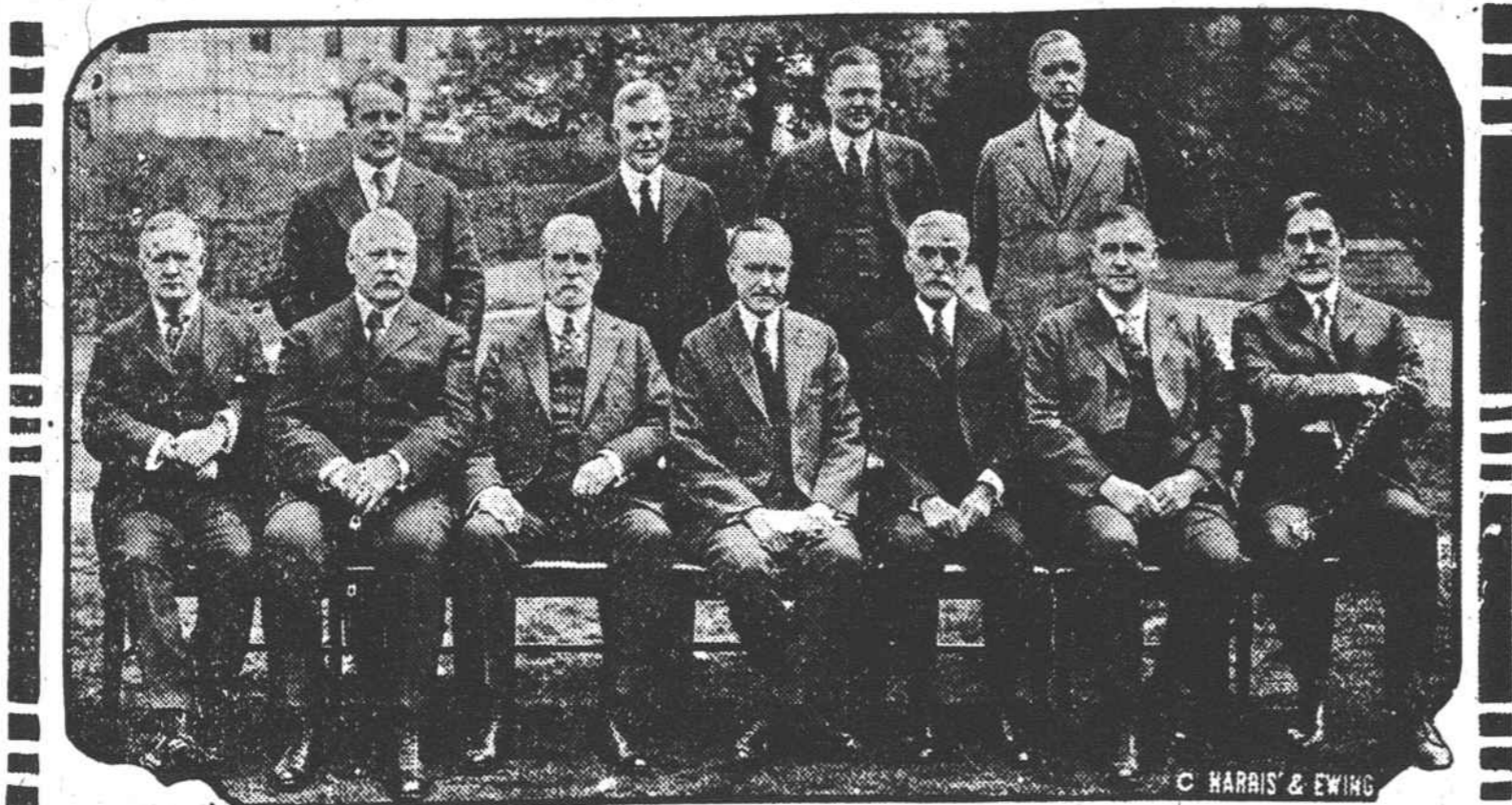

"Path of Death" of the Amalfi Landslide



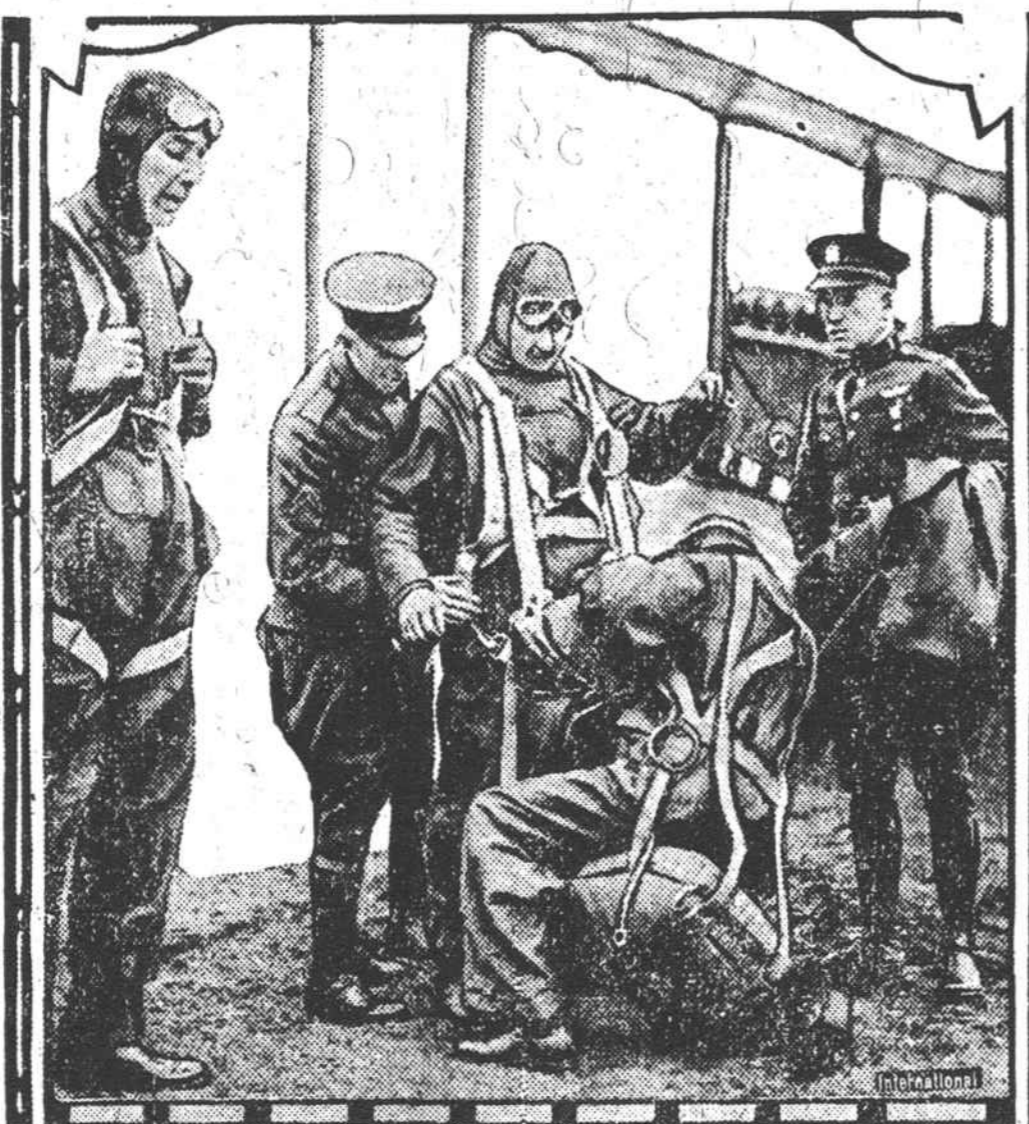

President With His Cabinet as Now Constituted



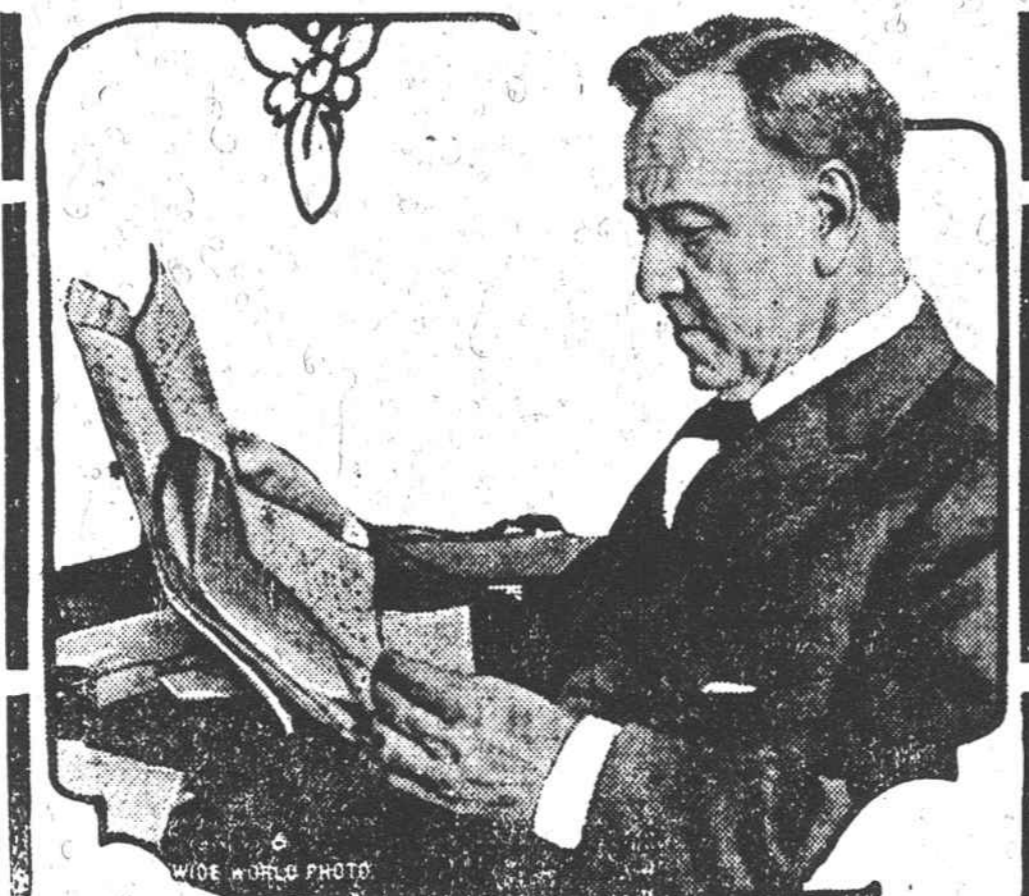

At Work on His Wilson Biography



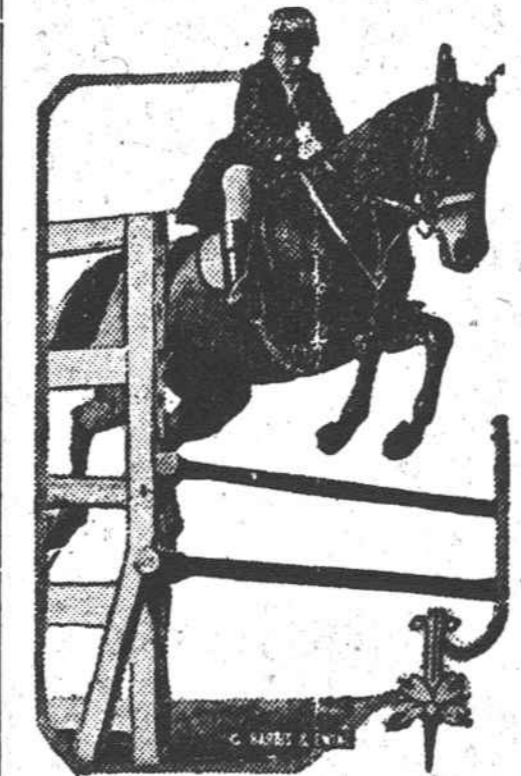
Josephus Daniels, former secretary of the navy, at work on his book, "The Life of Woodrow Wilson," in Washington, where he will remain until the biography has been completed.

MAKES WAY FOR ARIZONA



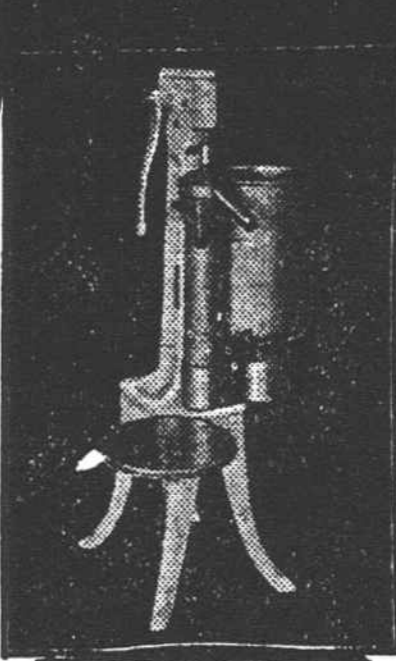
