

HARKINS NAMED CLERK OF WESTERN DISTRICT

Judge E. Y. Webb appointed Thos. J. Harkins of Asheville as district attorney for the western district of North Carolina. The Asheville man will hold the place under temporary appointment until the Department of Justice has taken permanent action. Mr. Harkins is a Republican and for a number of years was assistant district attorney. Reorganization of the western district was made necessary by the creation of a middle district at the last session of Congress.

NORTH CAROLINA TAX COL-

LECTIONS PASS 2 MILLIONS

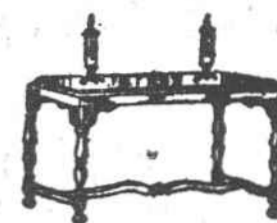
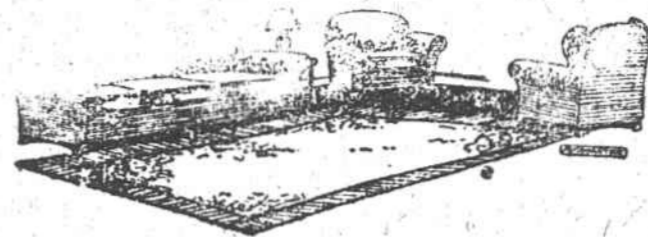

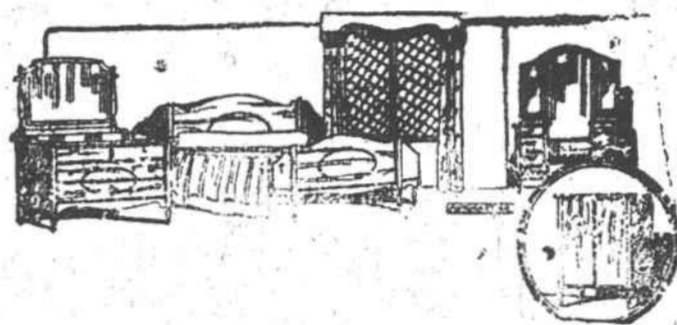
