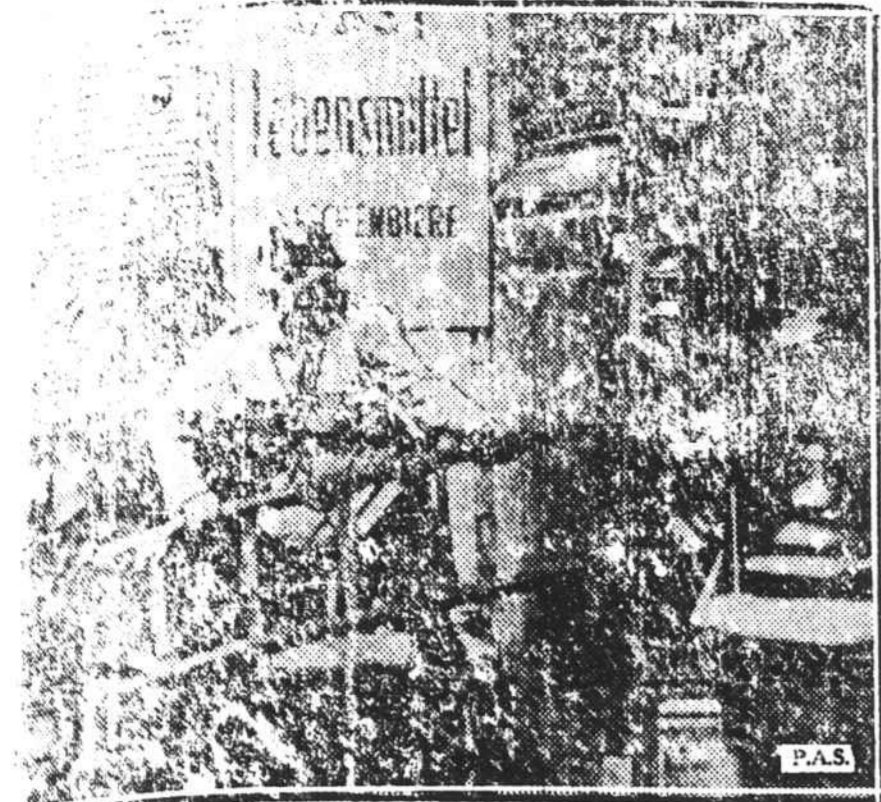


Annexes Austria Without A Shot



VIENNA . . . Acting on orders, Austrian troops fell back before the German forces who rumbled across the border in motorized units. Suddenly 100 huge airplanes flew 3,000 heavily armed soldiers to the Capitol where they immediately took possession of all public buildings, newspapers and communication offices. Here a squad took the gate to the Ravag building which houses the radio broadcasting company while Vienna police stand by.

Hitler's No. 1



VIENNA . . . Quickly following his appointment as Minister of the Interior by former Austrian Chancellor Schussnigg, Dr. Seyss-Inquart (above) became leader of the pro-Nazi state, effecting the resignation of President Miklas, but with Reichsfuehrer Adolf Hitler as the real power behind the throne. As expected, Hitler took over the Austrian government immediately, placing both countries under one rule and completing the "Anschluss."

TVA Chairman Asks Quiz By Congress



WASHINGTON, D. C. . . . TVA, often the target for outside attacks, may be questioned from within. Directors Harcourt Morgan (left) and Arthur Hays Sulzberger (right) demand the resignation of Chairman Arthur Hays Sulzberger, charging "lack of cooperation" and a policy of "obstruction." A White House conference failed to patch up the quarrel and Chairman Morgan insisted on a full Congressional investigation. The two men seem loathe to face.
